Would you like to share your enjoyment of nature in our day camp? Consider being a **Team Leader** (High School) or **Camp Assistant** (Middle School).

Our campers will be in grades 3 to 6 and will be in teams of six campers with one high school age **Team Leader** and one middle school aged **Camp Assistant**. Youth leaders will be mentored by one of our Volunteer Naturalists. The team will participate in activities such as learning about natural habitats, nature and wildlife observation, photography, and more! This year, we have worked to design even more "trail time" for campers.

There will be a training session for the **Team Leaders** and **Camp Assistants** before the start of Nature Camp. Youth leaders will become familiar with the staff, refuge, the Camp program. A special emphasis will be given to group management skills. Time will also be given to practice some of the new camp activities. The training will be held at the Refuge.

This is a great opportunity to gain leadership experience and acquire at least 40 service learning hours.

### **Skills and Requirements**

**Requirements:** Letter of recommendation and completed application. Youth leaders must attend training.

**Age:** The minimum age for these positions is 14 years, but if you've attended our camp in a previous session, you need only be 13. If you've attended two years of our camp, you need only be twelve years old.

You are welcome to apply for one or both sessions.

**Desired Skills:** Successful candidates will be responsible, dependable, patient and respectful of others, enthusiastic, and eager to learn and share knowledge about nature and wildlife in a fun and friendly environment.
