**PAYMENT:** Payment is due with registration. Checks should be addressed to: Friends of Tualatin River National Wildlife Refuge

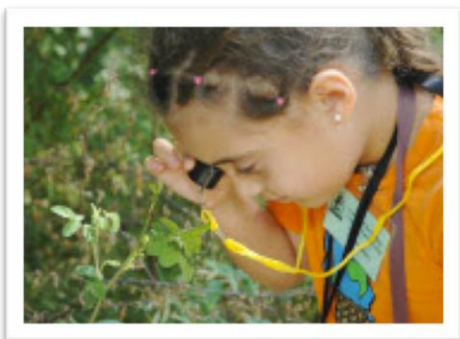
**REFUNDS:** \$50 back before 6/1/17; No refunds after 6/1/17
